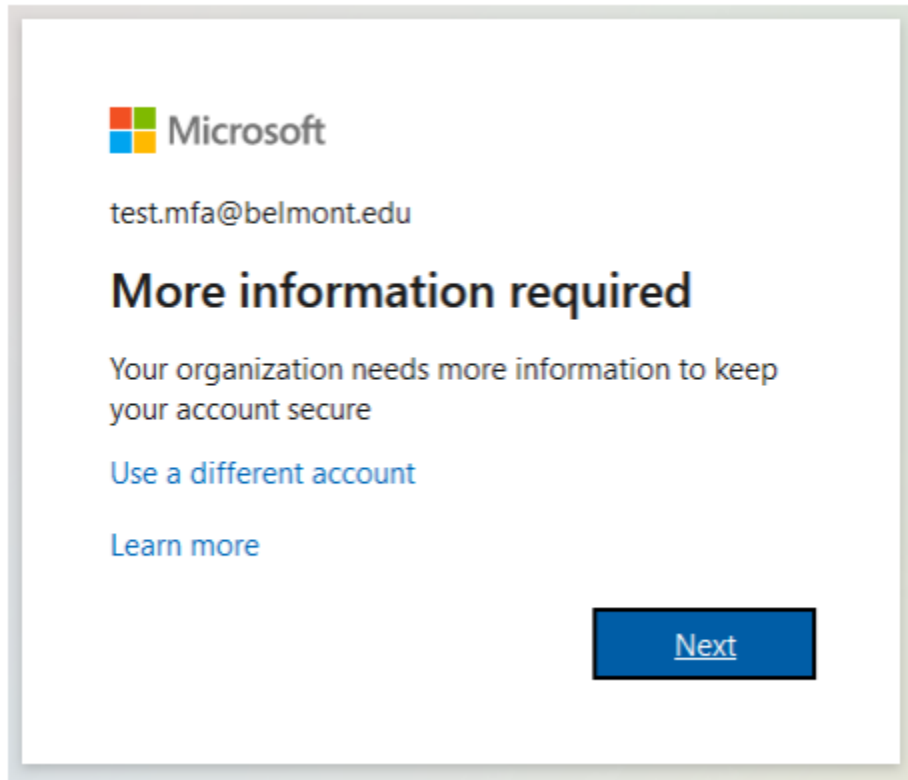

Scan the QR code

Use the Microsoft Authenticator app to scan the QR code. This will connect the Microsoft Authenticator app with your account.

After you scan the QR code, choose "Next".

Start the Microsoft authenticator app on your phone, click Credentials at the bottom of the page, and scan the QR code on your screen.



Accept a verifiable credential for more control of your identity

Some websites and organizations now offer verifiable credentials. They make account setup simpler and safer, while giving you more visibility and control over your personal data.

A website typically offers a credential through a QR code. Scan the code to get started.

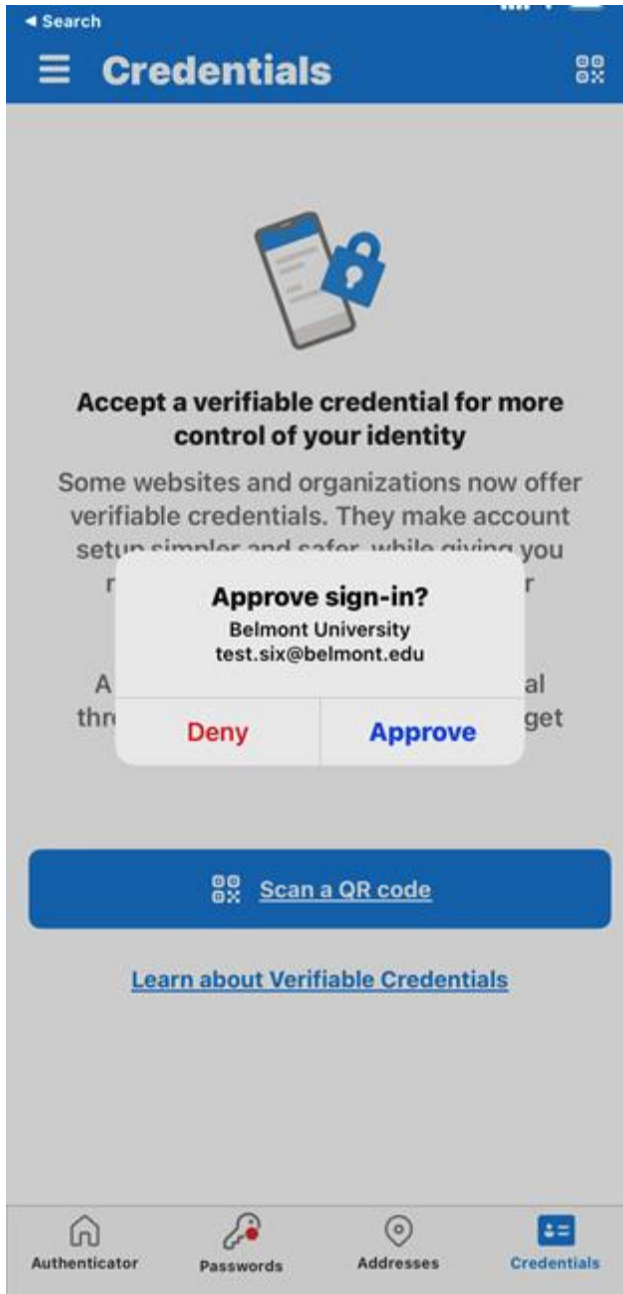
